Dear ice dancers,

We cordially invite you to the Ice Dance Seminar from 31st August until 5th September 2026 at the Ice Sports Centre in Oberstdorf. You can put together your own personal program at this seminar. In addition to the technique and dance expression, we will also take as much time as possible for ice dancing. By using several coaches, we want to achieve an optimal learning result. The seminar takes place in cooperation with the ERC Munich and is open to all interested ice dancers, including those from other clubs. For participants who are not members of the ERC Munich, a temporary membership (€ 10) is required for insurance reasons. The training sessions on the ice last 90 minutes. The coaching language is German and English. Here is an overview of the entire schedule:

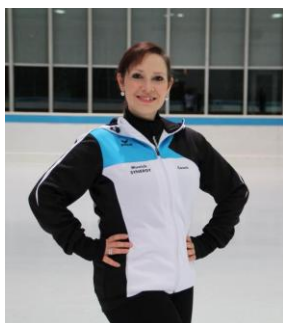

General information and conditions:

Location: Eissportzentrum Oberstdorf, Roßbichlstraße 2-6, 87561 Oberstdorf, Germany

Capacity: The capacity for each session is strictly limited. The registration is processed on a first-come, first-served basis.

Liability: By registering and participating, participants assume all inherent risks associated with ice skating and agree to release the venue and its staff from any and all liability for personal injury or property damage. The organizer assumes no liability for possible accidents and other damages to participants and accompanying persons. Participants must be fit for sports. Participation is at your own risk and responsibility. Please use appropriate protective equipment at your own discretion.

Private lessons: The allocation of private lessons depends on the receipt of bookings, the availability of the coaches and organizational conditions. The division of the private lessons will be announced on site at the latest.

Conditions of participation: Participation in the ice dance seminar is only possible if the course fee has been transferred in full to the organizer. The participant can only use the ice at the booked times.

Reimbursement of fees: In the event of cancellation of participation by the course participant, the fees will only be refunded in the event of proven illness (e.g. with a medical certificate).

Course cancellation: If the course or individual parts of the course are cancelled by the organizer for whatever reason, claims against the organizer for payment of secondary costs or losses which arise from the cancellation of e.g. booked trips or booked hotels cannot be made. In this case, the participant will only be refunded the course fee.

VAT: According to sec. 19 para. 1 of the German VAT Act, no VAT is charged as a small business.

Behaviour: All participants are required to be considerate of other skaters for safety reasons. Dancers in the dance pattern have priority in International Ice Dance. Conversations were to be held on the board. The group lessons, the international ice dance as well as the private lessons refer to ice dance, so figure skating pirouettes and jumps are to be avoided.

Exclusion from the course: The organizer cannot carry out an examination of the ability or suitability of the participant. However, if the coaches have doubts about the suitability of the participant, they are entitled to exclude the participant from participation for safety reasons. In this case, the course fee may be refunded proportionately.

Schedule: For organizational reasons, the organizer or the ice sports centre may make changes to the schedule. If training times are omitted as a result, the course fee will be refunded on a pro rata basis.

Short-term membership: The acquisition of a temporary membership (short-term membership) in ERC Munich is required for the duration of the ice dance course. The period of short-term membership begins with the start of the ice dance seminar and ends with the end of the ice dance seminar, without the need for separate cancellation. The fee of the short-term membership is 10 Euros.
